

Calling for Applications for recruitment to the Post of District Vidatha Officer of Management Assistant Supra Class of the State Ministry of Technology & Innovation under the Ministry of Higher Education, Technology & Innovation

Applications are invited from candidates who have satisfied the qualification as at 30/07/2018, for recruitment to the post of District Vidatha Officer of the Management Assistant Supra Class of the State Ministry of Technology & Innovation under the Ministry of Higher Education, Technology & Innovation, in terms of the provisions of the scheme of recruitment approved on 04/01/2018, in respect of Management Assistant Supra Class of the said Ministry. Retired Science & Technology officers who had been in service as at 30/07/2018 could also apply for the same.

## 1. Qualifications

- 1.1 Educational Qualifications: Should have earned a degree in Science/ Mathematics accepted by the University Grants Commission either from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission or from an institution recognized by the University Grants Commission as a degree awarding institution
- 1.2 Experience: Should have completed 15 years of active and satisfactory service period as Science & Technology Officers.
- 1.3 Physical Eligibility: All candidates should be physically and mentally fit to discharge the duties of the post and to serve in any part of the island
- 1.4 Other: (I) Applicants should be of excellent moral character
  - (II) Should have completed 05 years of satisfactory service period immediately prior to the date of promotion
  - (III) All qualifications necessary for the recruitment to the post should have been fulfilled in all aspects as at the date calling for applications.
  - (IV) Age is irrelevant
- 02. Number of the Vacancies: 25
- 03. Salary Scale: In terms of Public Administration Circular No. 03/2016, the salary code entitled to this post is MN 7 -2016 while the salary scale entitled is Rs. 41,580-11 x 755-18 x 1,030 68,425 (Monthly)

(The payment of salaries and other matters will be carried out in terms of the provisions of the Public Administration Circular no. 03/2016)

04. Method of recruitment: Recruitments will be made through an eligibility evaluation interview without the conduct of a written examination as mentioned in the approved Scheme of Recruitment, for this time only, as per the directive no. PSC/EST/03-03/08/2017 dated 26/04/2019 issued by the public Service Commission. Accordingly, an interview board appointed by the Public Service Commission, will conduct an eligibility evaluation interview as per the below mentioned marks scheme approved by the Public Service Commission and thereafter, recruitments will be made by the Public Service Commission according to the order of marks scored and corresponding to the number of vacancies. The number of officers being recruited and the effective date of the appointment will be determined by the Public Service Commission.
